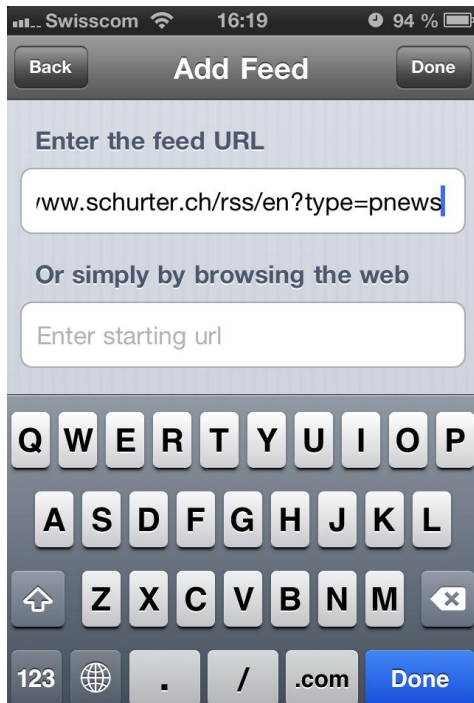


1 Adding an RSS Feed to Reeder for iPhone / iPad

If you use Reeder for iPhone (or iPad or Mac), click on Subscriptions and then “Edit”.

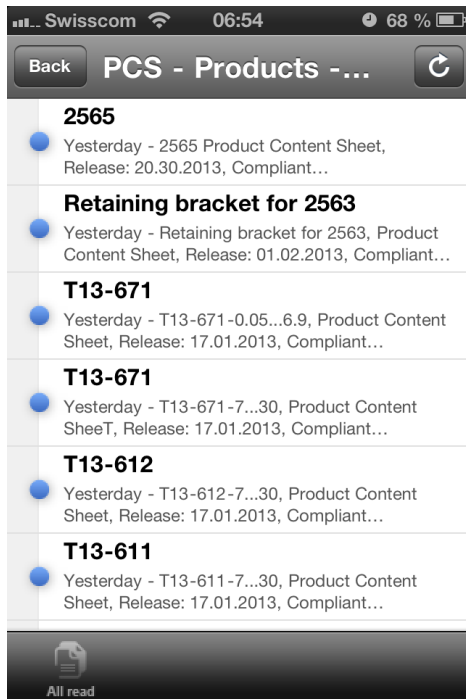


You can then paste the URL of the RSS feed, which will then appear as below. The number of new / unread articles appear in purple next to the feed.

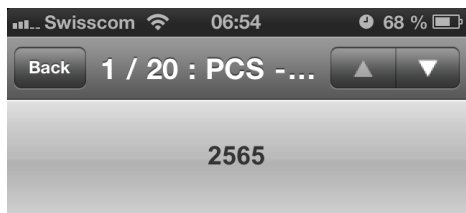

Touching the feed allows you to see the list of articles in the Feed.



Touching the article allows you to view the article. Touching the title allows you to download the file (in this case a Product Content Sheet).

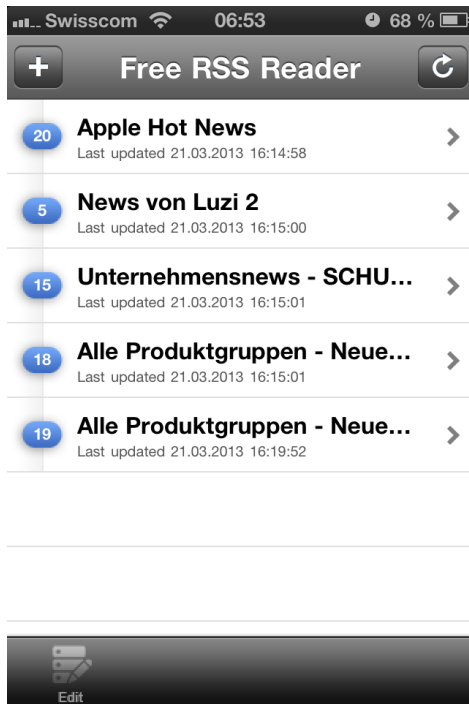
